FOURTH DISTRIBUTION AT UMER KOT, SINDH

Fourth Distribution at Umer Kot, Sindh in collaboration with GWF and UCC. Around 75 families has been facilitated and 20 children has been provided with a pack containing useful things for children. This place was approximately 6 km far from the main road. No one is reaching inside the villages because Organizations, initially rescuing the affected people who are staying at the Road side but our local partner churches assessed these areas and found the needy areas and people. Thanks to our team for all the efforts they are making for the betterment of our beloved #Pakistan.



THIRD DISTRIBUTION AT MIRPUR KHAS

Third Distribution at Mirpur Khas, Interior Sindh in collaboration with GWF and UCC . Around 75 families has been facilitated in this distribution. Situation of the people and environment of living is also monitored to assess the basic and immediate needs of the affected people. Beneficiaries are identified by the local churches to distribute the food packages among. Flood water is still and producing mosquitoes causing malaria and dengue. Need of draining the water from affected areas should be on priority to make the people safe from the deadly diseases. Thanks to the team and local church partners support to help us in distribution.





SECOND DISTRIBUTION IN FLOOD AFFECTEES AT MIRPUR KHAS, SINDH

Second distribution at Mirpur Khas, Sindh with joint efforts of GWF and UCC and Shaloom Church. Now we are as UCC, Food Packages has distributed among 70 affected people of Mirpur khas. We have assessed the needs of people during the distribution and discussion with local people that they need further medical ailments because malaria and dengue is spreading from dirty water of Flood, they need temporary tents and shelter to restore themselves because winter is coming, they need more Food and Non-Food Items to survive in these horrible situations caused by Flood. We need more support and your prayers to rescue and relief the affectees and share the Love of Christ with them.
